Meditate on how God has forgiven you, how he puts up with your sin, and how he continues to use you despite past failure. Also on Phil. 3. Choose your concerns carefully. Distinguish between valid concerns and simple annoyances. Before you express your concerns to someone, make sure (e.g. by soliciting outside input) that it's an issue God is concerned about as well. 4. Each week at Home Church come prepared to encourage at least 2 people.
