Preschool at CCS

1 Backpack – optional, but recommended.
1 set Extra Clothing, for summer and winter, labeled and in a plastic bag.
2 Photos of child at their present age that may be cut for their cubbies.
1 pkg. Play Dough *

1 pack of themed stickers: Nursery Rhymes, Jesus' faces, people from other countries, health and safety, seasons, holidays, US flags, President's Day, Martin Luther Day, vehicles, occupations, friendship, foods, plants, fish, cats, frogs.*
1 Egg carton*
Class rewards (small toys for treasure chest) MWF Class Only

Kindergarten at CCS

1 Backpack (big enough to hold a folder, with name on it)
1 pair Blunt Fiskars Scissors*
1 Double Pocket Folder for homework w/ name on it
4 Glue Sticks, jumbo size* (prefer Elmer's Glue Sticks)
6 Pencils, yellow, No. 2, with erasers* Already SHARPENED please. (DO NOT buy recycled wood pencils, they are difficult to sharpen.)

2 Photographs of your child, recent (will not be returned), with full name on back
1 pkg. Stickers*
1 bx. Crayons (no more than 24)*
1 pkg. Washable Markers (pkg. of 8)*
Class Rewards (small toys for grab bag)* OPTIONAL

* NOTE: These items will be shared with classmates. Do not put names on these. Please explain this to your child. Thank you.

First Grade at CCS - Please bring the first day of school

1 Backpack (with name on it)
1 set **Double Pocket** Folders, 1 each of 5 Colors (Red, Blue, Green, Purple, Yellow) (labeled)
1 **Heavy duty plastic, double-pocket folder** for homework, **with tangs for 3 hole punched papers** (We will be putting papers into the holes in the folder during the year)
2 Doodle Pads (cheap drawing paper)
30 good quality yellow painted #2 pencils, six sided for community use. Leave out of the pencil box (not labeled)
1 **Supply Box** (large enough for all supplies) (12"x5"shallow enough to fit inside the desks, no shoe box sized please)

Place the following supplies inside supply/pencil box:

1 Pink or Green Eraser
1 Ruler (centimeters and inches) labeled
1 box Crayons (no more than 24) individually labeled
1 box Colored Pencils (set of 8) individually labeled
2 red ink ball point pens, labeled
1 pair blunt Fiskars scissors, labeled
2 pkg. Washable Markers (pkg. of 8) (1 pkg. for each semester. We will store 2nd pkg. for later)
2 Large Glue sticks labeled, (or 3 small sticks) extra to be stored until needed, individually labeled
1 small margarine or cream cheese container with the following coins inside for math: 23 pennies, 8 nickels, 10 dimes, 1 quarter

Please limit supplies to this list. Space is limited in the tool boxes.

* NOTE: **Please label everything with your child's name using permanent marker.** Take all tools out of their packaging and place in the tool box (except 2nd pkg. of markers, the extra glue sticks, and community shared pencils) **to be sure it all fits. Please be sure to label each crayon, marker, and colored pencil as they do end up on the floor.**

Second Grade at CCS

1 12" ruler with inches and centimeters
1 Backpack (with name on it)
1 Bible – New Living Translation
1 Clipboard
60 Pencils, No. 2, with erasers - sharpened
1 set Double Pocket Folders, 1 each of 6 Colors (Red, Blue, Green, Purple, Yellow and a fun folder)
2 pads Drawing Paper
1 Margarine tub with lid and labeled with name. Put inside 6 quarters, 10 dimes, 10 nickels, and 20 pennies...

1 Pencil Box (12x5): put the following supplies inside marked with initials, we'll store extras until needed

Third Grade at CCS

1 Backpack
1 Plastic, multi-pocket, folder with at least 7 pockets (for keeping papers from all subjects organized and in one place)
1 3 ring binder (½" wide)
1 Bible – New Living Translation (2004 updated version, if possible)
1 pkg. Colored Pencils (12 or more)
1 Pair Fiskars Scissors
1 Glue stick
3 Highlighters (yellow, green, pink)
1 plastic, Pencil Box, big enough to hold all the loose items, except

the ruler – larger boxes will not fit in desk
40 Pencils, No. 2, with erasers (mechanical pencils are also OK)
2 Pink or Green Erasers (big)
1 Ruler (inches and metric - centimeters AND millimeters)
2 pkgs. (300 sheets altogether) WIDE ruled, Notebook paper
2 pkg. Stickers
10 Dry Erase Markers (for whiteboard, you may need to restock mid-year)
1 lb. Jolly Rancher hard candy (Sam's Club has a good deal on a big bag, if you can afford it)

*Note: Please NO Trapper Keepers or pencil sharpeners. Please label all the pencil box supplies. Also, you may be asked to purchase poster boards later in the year.

Fourth Grade at CCS

1 Bible – New Living Translation
1 Calculator
1 pkg. Colored Pencils (8 or more)
1 pkg. Crayons (8 or more)
1 Seven-pocket File Folder, accordion style, plastic
3 Double Pocket Folders – Plain solid red, blue, green.
1 Eraser, Large, Pink Pearl
1 pair Fiskars Scissors
1 Glue Stick, jumbo
2 Highlighters – send 1 in with student, keep other at home for future use.
3 Dry Erase markers – wide tip, send 1 in with student, and keep others at home for future use.
2 Clear Plastic Paper Protector Pockets or Folder Covers
1 pkg. Index Cards, 3x5, ruled, 50 or more, in a spiral or bound

package (not loose)
6 Ink Pens, blue or black Send 2 in with student, keep the rest at home for future needs.
2 pkg. Notebook Paper, wide ruled (200 count) Send in 1 package; keep the rest at home for future needs.
1 Pencil/Supply Box (no taller than 3 ¼ inches)
20 Pencils, No.2, plain, non-recycled wood Send 5 in with student, keep the remainder at home for future use.
1 Ruler (millimeters and inches)
1 Protractor
1 compass (for drawing circles)
2 bags Smarties Candy
2 bags Candy, bite size (i.e.: hard candy, caramels, small candy bars, Jolly Ranchers, etc.)

NOTE: Please do not send a binder to school with your child. They are cumbersome and do not fit well in the desks.

Fifth Grade at CCS

1 Bible – New Living Translation or NIV
1 bx. Colored Pencils (12 or more)
2 Ink Pens, RED
1 box Washable Markers
1 Sock, clean, old – used as whiteboard eraser
1 Multi-pocket Folder, plastic
6 Ink Pens, blue or black
1 pair Fiskars Scissors
2 Glue Stick – small
3 Highlighter – yellow, green, pink
2 pkg. Notebook Paper (200 count), college rule, loose, no spirals please.

1 Pencil case or supply box (just big enough for their pens, pencils, and loose items.)
20 Pencils, with erasers – mechanical or regular
1 Ruler (metric and inches)
5 White board markers, dry erase, black, blue green, or red (no light colors)
1 bag Jolly Rancher candies, 1 bag Smarties, large bag (we pass them out for every test)
1 pkg. Index Cards, 3"x5", lined, loose
1 spiral notebook with a pocket (at least 100 pages)

NOTE: Science Fair boards, poster boards will be purchased later in the year, as needed. The packages of notebook paper will be collected and shared as needed. You may also want some notebook paper at home for homework. NO TRAPPER KEEPERS please!
