

Christian Growth – Grading Policy

To complete Christian Growth class, you must:

- Score at least 70% (48 points) on the final exam.
- Attend a minimum of 8 out of 9 classes.
- Accumulate at least 70 total points from homework, quizzes, and the final exam (see below).

NOTE: Xenos keeps a permanent transcript of your final grades for each class.

Successful completion of the following classes is required to become a deacon (Servant Team member): Introduction to the Bible (1 unit), Christian Growth (1 unit), Christian Ministry (3 units)

Point Values

- A perfect score on the unit final exam is worth... 69 points
- 8 homework assignments are worth... 16 points
 (2 points per satisfactorily completed assignment).
- 3 quizzes are worth 15 total points (5 points per quiz). 15 points

*YOU **MUST** GET AT LEAST 48 points (70%) on the final to pass this course.

Final Exam

- The final exam will include questions on the memory verses, true/false and multiple choice and short essays. You will also be asked to define key terms. A review guide has been provided.
- You must score 70% (48 points) or better to pass the course.
- If you have an unforeseen emergency (e.g. sickness; unscheduled business trip), you must arrange with your instructor to take the exam as soon as possible. If, after one week, we have not received your exam at the Study Center and you have not contacted us, you will fail the course.
- If you fail the exam, you will be notified by mail. You may take a make-up exam at the Study Center within one week of receiving notification of the failed exam.

Quizzes

- Questions will ask you to apply memory passages in response to practical issues.
- 3 quizzes will be given, covering the memory verses from the first week through the previous week's material. You must take the quiz on the specified date and time unless you have made prior arrangements with your instructor.

Attendance

- You must attend a minimum 8 out of 9 classes (unless otherwise arranged with the instructor) in order to pass this course.
- Attendance will be taken at the beginning of the 2nd half of each class (after the break).

Assignments

- Each assignment must be handed in at the beginning of the class when it is due. Except for unforeseen emergencies, instructors will not accept late assignments.

Memory Verses

- You will have 2 or 3 verses per week. Don't fall behind in this important area of the course.
- Work on memorization a little bit each day and you'll find you retain the verses longer. If you cram right before the quizzes and exam, you'll quickly forget what you've learned.
- * next to the verse means memorize the book and chapter reference, the *exact verse quote*, and its application.
- ** means memorize the book and chapter reference, *general content of the verse* (provided at the end of the student notes), and its application.
- Pay attention to the short summary of the verse provided at the end of each week's student outline. These summaries indicate how the verse might be used on a quiz.
