**Week 1**

**Memory Verses**

**Week 1**

- 2 Cor. 8:7\* - Consistent, sacrificial giving is a non-optional component of spiritual vitality and maturity. We cannot be true disciples of Christ without this.
- 2 Cor. 9:6-11\*\* - God blesses bountiful financial giving in a variety of ways.
- 1 Cor. 16:2\* - Our financial giving should be regular and consistent.

**Week 2**

- 1 Timothy 6:9\* - The *desire* to get rich endangers your walk with God
- 1 Timothy 6:17-19\*\* - It's not wrong to be rich, but the rich have special temptations and unique responsibilities to use their money to have eternal impact on people.

**Week 3**

- Rom. 12:2\* - We need minds renewed by truth to be able to discern God's will.
- Jn. 7:17\* - We need to be willing to do God's will to be able to discern his will.
- Matt. 13:12\* - We need to obey what we already know of God's will to learn more of his will.

**Week 4**

- Rom. 15:14\* - every believer is competent to instruct/admonish.
- 1Thess 5:14\* - All believers challenged to admonish, encourage.
- Heb 10:24,25\* - Consider how to encourage one another; don't forsake meeting together.
