**Week 1**

- With respect to evangelism, briefly describe God's part, our part as witnesses and the hearer's part.
- Be able to describe the symptoms that are often present when a church has lost its focus on evangelism.
- Be familiar with the 5 important communication guidelines when speaking with non-Christians.
- Definitions: Great Commission, open doors.

**Week 2**

- Be able to explain “Top Line/ Bottom Line”
- Be able to respond to the accusation that missionaries are cultural imperialists.
- Understand the issue of contextualization.
- Know the five practical things that we can do to help minister to the poor.
- Be able to respond to the misconception that people are poor because they are lazy.
- Definitions: cultural imperialism, contextualization.

**Week 3**

- Know and describe the seven principles of financial giving.
- Be able to define stewardship, and able to contrast attitudes of owner vs. steward
- What is simple living, and why is it important? Is tithing appropriate?
- Definition: tithe, stewardship.

**Week 4**

- Be familiar with the four principles of guidance.
- Be familiar with the "Road Signs" used in discovering God's will.
- Know the five ministries in which all Christians should be involved (areas of uniformity).
- Be able to define spiritual gifts, ministries and effects.
- Know the practical steps to discover what one's gifts are.
- Definition: spiritual gifts.

**Week 5**

- Be able to define encouragement and admonition.
- Know the types of encouragement.
- Know the principles of giving and receiving admonition.
- Be sure to know memory verses and their meaning.
- Definition: admonition, encouragement.

## Memory Verses

### Week 1

- 2 Cor. 5:18-20\* – We are ambassadors for Christ.
- Col. 4:3-6\*\* – Pray for open doors.
- Matt. 28:18-20\* – The Great Commission, in which Jesus commands the church to both evangelize and train people from every people group.

### Week 2

- Matt. 24:14\* – Jesus will return to establish his kingdom only after the Great Commission is fulfilled.
- Prov. 14:31\* – We honor or reproach God by how we treat the poor.
- Ps. 140:12\* – God is committed to the cause of the afflicted and justice for the poor.

### Week 3

- 2 Cor. 8:7\* – Consistent, sacrificial giving is a non-optional component of spiritual vitality and maturity. We cannot be true disciples of Christ without this.
- 2 Cor. 9:6-11\*\* – God blesses bountiful financial giving in a variety of ways.
- 1 Cor. 16:2\* – Our financial giving should be regular and consistent.

### Week 4

- Rom. 12:2\* – God's will for our life revolves around our sanctification and his role for our lives in his purpose here on earth.
- Jn. 7:17\* – Learning God's will is predicated upon our first being willing to do his will, even before knowing what it is.
- Matt. 13:12\* – As we are responsive to God's will in our lives, he will continue to unfold his will in the other areas. The reverse is also true.

### Week 5

- Rom. 15:14\* – All Christians have the responsibility to admonish one another. Goodness (love) and (biblical) knowledge are the two keys to effective admonition.
- 1 Thes. 5:14\* – All Christians should practice encouragement and admonition as appropriate.
- Heb. 10:24,25\* – Effective encouragement requires prayerful forethought. We should come together with other Christians willing and ready to encourage them.
