

The Promises of God

“Without wavering, let us hold tightly to the hope we say we have, for God can be trusted to keep his promise.” – Hebrews 10:23

“His divine power has given us everything needed for life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. “No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, that you may be able to endure it.” – 1 Corinthians 10:13
